# WORLDWIDE REPORT DAY #4

**CAMPAIGN SIGHTFIRST II**  
LIONS' VISION FOR ALL

## More than US\$18 million reported in unrecorded funds raised!

**Wednesday, June 13** marked our fourth Campaign SightFirst II Worldwide Report Day. Telephone calls from 46 National/Multi-National Coordinators revealed new information about Campaign SightFirst II fund-raising progress.

Throughout the day, National/Multi-National Coordinators reported their area's total funds raised to date. These report calls revealed that clubs have raised more than US\$112 million for CSFII, significantly more than the US\$94.1 million that has been officially received and processed to date by LCIE.

These funds raised will be an exciting announcement at the 2007 International Convention and the launch of the final year of fund raising, The Year of CSFII.














Lions around the world will work through the final year of CSFII to exceed our minimum goal of US\$150 million in advance of July 2008. Thank you to each CSFII coordinator and Lions club continuing to fulfill our mission as Knights of the Blind. Through SightFirst, we are fighting blindness and changing the world.
